Cór agus Ranganna Amhránaíochta

Ta gliondar orainn go mbeidh Doimnic Mac Giolla Bhríde ag fillleadh go Caisleán an Mhuilinn ar an 27ú Bealtaine chun sraith ranganna a shocrú agus chun cór Gaelach a chur ar bun sa cheantar. Beidh cúig seachtain rang ar fáil sa chéad dul síos agus beidh siad ar siúl gach Aoine go dtí an 27ú Meitheamh. Seo leanas na ama a mbeidh na himeachtaí ar siúl:

- 4.00in-4.45in: Rang amhránaíocht le haghaidh páistí idir 8-11 bliana
- 4.45-5.30in: Rang amhránaíocht le haghaidh páistí idir 12-16 bliana
- 6.00-7.00in: Rang amhránaíocht le haghaidh daoine fásta
- 7.00-8.30: An Cór

Beidh na ranganna ar fad ar siúl i nDún Eigse, Bóthar Bhaile Átha Cliath, i gCaisleán an Mhuilinn agus beidh £5 táille an duine le haghaidh na ranganna agus £7 le haghaidh an chóir i comhair an cúig seachtain ar fad. Chuir Caisleán an Mhuilinn isteach le haghaidh comórtais TG4 d'arbh ainm The G-Team. An sprioc atá leis an comórtas seo ná mion Gaeltacht a dhéanamh de bailte Galltacha fud fad na tíre le haghaidh lá amháin. Ar lá 'G-day' tiocfaidh na ceamaraí chuig na bailte beaga le moltóirí chun amharc ar an phobal ag déanamh dianiarracht, is cuma caighdeán a gcuid Gaeilge, Gaeilge a labhairt agus sult a bhaint asti i rith an lae.

Is é Caisleán an Mhuilinn ceann de'n dhá bhaile deag atá piocaithe amach as bhreis agus 60 bailte a chuir isteach sa chomórtas. Agus tá duais €40,000 ar fáil don bhuaiteoir le húsáid chun a gceantar áitiúil a chur chun cinn.

Choir and Singing Classes

We are delighted that Doimnic Mac Giolla Bhríde will be returning to Castlewellaan on May 27th to commence teaching a variety of classes and to establish an Irish language choir for the locality. Five weeks of classes will be available initially and they will run every Friday until June 27th. The following gives the times during which the events will take place:

- 4.00-4.45pm: Singing classes for children between 8-11 years
- 4.45-5.30pm: Singing classes for 12-16 year olds
- 6.00-7.00: singing classes for 16-116 years
- 7.00-8.30: The Choir

All these events will take place in The Lodge, The Dublin Road, Castlewellaan and they will cost £5 per person for the entire five weeks for classes and £7 for the choir. Registration will take place on the first day at the Lodge and it will be possible to pay then. This is a pilot scheme and we hope that these events will all recommence again in September. With the exception of the classes for 8-11 year olds fluency in Irish is not necessary to attend these events.

Castlewellaan recently entered for a TG4 competition called The G-Team. The aim behind this competition is to turn towns throughout Ireland into small Gealtachtacts for the day. On G-Day, the cameras and judges will arrive into the towns to watch the population doing its best, regardless of the standard of their Irish, to speak and enjoy Irish throughout the day.

Castlewellaan has been chosen alongside only 12 other towns from over 60 towns which entered for the competition. And a prize of €40,000 is up for grabs for the winning town to spend on developing their own locality.

G-Day won't be an average day in Castlewellaan, Glór Uachtar Tíre is planning a host of festivities to give the local population and visitors the opportunity to have a shot at speaking Irish and to enjoy the day. Irish will be spoken in the shops, in the restaurants, in the offices and on the streets – with your help!

G-Day will take place on the 15th of June and the programme will be televised on TG4 in the Autumn. Come along and enjoy the fun of G-day!

Play Time

Every year there are number of children from the local Irish language pre-school who, for different reasons, do not go on to attend the local Irish language primary school. These children's parents tend to want the kids to have the opportunity to retain and improve their Irish.

The parents came up with idea that it might be useful if the children could spend an hour and a half each week playing through Irish. As a result 'Seal Sugradh' or 'Play Time' is starting on May 28th between 10.00am -11.30am.

'Play Time' will be based in the Naíscóil Uachtar Tíre premises on the Circular Road in Castlewellaan. There will be a team who have experience with caring for pre-school children but Glór Uachtar Tíre is also inviting University and A-level students who are studying Irish to come along and help on a voluntary basis to help out and to improve their Irish.
